



## 1. Flight Validation Pilot recurrent course

Questions at a glance	Answer
<b>Duration</b>	2 working days
<b>Tuition Fee</b>	CHF 1100 including 2 lunches and one dinner, not including accommodation/ breakfast
<b>ICAO recognised?</b>	No, there is no such thing as an ICAO recognition for training. ANI is a State-approved training provider and complies with all ICAO training regulations.
<b>Certificate?</b>	ANI Certificate, FVPs require a State Approval.
<b>Pre-requisites?</b>	Yes. Please see below for details.
<b>Daily schedule?</b>	9.00 - 16.30
<b>Is this mandatory?</b>	For some States yes, approvals will be frozen if recurrent training is not completed on a regular basis.
<b>Location and Venue?</b>	Zug/Switzerland. Smaller Classes will be held in the ANI headquarters, larger classes at the Parkhotel Zug.
